Information Sheet La Ligue's 5th Annual Family Salt-Water Fishing Trip Sausalito's Clipper Yacht Harbor Fishing Date, July 17, 2010

La Ligue Henry IV's President, Michel Baylocq, and its social committee cordially invite you to our 5th Annual Family Salt-Water Fishing Trip for salmon or halibut fishing. Last year's event was a great success, and we anticipate this year's will be even better.

The event is scheduled for July 17th. This time of year is usually a very productive fishing time. We can't guarantee the catch but chances are very good. The best fishing is within the bay or sometimes near the Marin County coast. We will go where the fish are.

La Ligue has reserved the Outer Limits. If it fills up and if there are 20 additional fishermen, we will charter the Hog Heaven and if there are an additional 20 fishermen we will charter the New Rayann. All boats have toilets and cabins to keep you warm. Reserve your boat early to be sure you entire group will be on the same boat. Reservation deadline is **July 10th**.

The Outer Limits is a 54-foot catamaran with space for 28 fishermen. The Hog Heaven is a 43-foot mono-hull with space for 25 fishermen. The New Rayann is a 50-foot mono-hull with space for 24 fishermen. The Outer Limits is an extra-wide, smooth-riding boat that we recommend for families with kids and first-time fishermen.

The deck hands and club members will assist the novice fishermen. The deck-hands will clean the fish on the return trip to the dock.

La Ligue will provide croissants and orange juice plus a lunch for each fisherman. The lunch will include a sandwich, pasta salad, chips, and a cookie. La Ligue will also provide beer, soda, and water. Please show on the Reservation Form your sandwich choice. You might bring extra food and drinks. Dress warmly. Wear a hat, rubber soled or water resistant shoes, and a water resistant jacket. Bring sunglasses and suntan lotion. If required, take your medical treatments for sea sickness the night before.

To make the event more exciting, we will have a fishing contest. The fisherman with the heaviest fish on each boat will win a \$20-prize and associated bragging rights. Ties will share the prize.

We expect this event to be a sell-out. Please reserve early. First come, first served.

Schedule

We will be leaving sharply at 5:45 AM from the Clipper Yacht Harbor in Sausalito. Directions are attached. We strongly advise everyone to arrive at 5:15 AM. It will give you enough time to access their boat and rent rods, reels, and tackle as necessary. Again, please arrive early to avoid being left stranded.

We will return to Sausalito at 3 PM.

Registration fees and other costs

Fees for a La Ligue member, one significant other, and children age ten or older are \$50 each. Fees for a guest are \$100. These fees do not include the customary tip of \$15 per fisherman to the senior deckhand.

The above fees do not include the cost of parking, fishing license, rod rental, and terminal tackle.

A one-day fishing license is \$13.40 for fisherman age 16 and older. Children under age 10 cannot attend this event. Children between age 10 and 15 do not need a fishing license. Fishing licenses, rental rods, and terminal tackle are available on the boat and the bait shop.

Rod and reel rental is \$12.00 which includes terminal tackle. You may use your own fishing gear.

Directions to Clipper Yacht Harbor in Sausalito

The Clipper Yacht Harbor (415-332-3500) is at the foot of Harbor Drive.

From 101 North-bound:

- 1. Take the exit toward Sausalito, 0.2 mi
- 2. Merge onto Bridgeway Blvd, 0.5 mi
- 3. Turn left at Harbor Dr (there is a light) 0.1 mi

From 101 South-bound:

- 1. Take the exit toward Sausalito, 0.3 mi
- 2. Turn left at Donahue St, 180 ft
- 3. Slight right to stay on Donahue St, 0.1 mi
- 4. Turn right at Bridgeway Blvd (follow the signs for Sausalito) 0.5 mi
- 5. Turn left at Harbor Dr (there is a light) 0.1 mi

Parking is \$2 per fisherman. Pay at the bait shop and obtain a parking receipt for your vehicle.
