Aspects of Tools

- Ampliative
 - Extends reach
 - Attitude: utopian
 - Reaction: fascination

Aspects of Tools

- Reductive
 - Lose direct experience
 - Attitude: dystopian
 - Reaction: fear

Tools

- Replace immediate (direct) experience with mediated (indirect) experience

Mastery

- When a good tool is mastered
- Mediation becomes transparent
- Tool is embodied
