  - b) As a knowledgeable computer scientist, do you find that the paper addresses the most interesting issues within its stated topic?
  - c) Does it waste time on relatively trivial or unimportant sub issues? Does it effectively isolate the few most important ideas, or does it seem to indiscriminately catalog loosely relate points?
  - d) Does the author present all sides of the complex issues fairly? Does (s)he effectively integrate material from a variety of sources? Cite examples where (s)he does and does not.
  - e) What other issues should the author pay attention to with this paper?
