Content--Accuracy

_____ x 6 =

- 0: Serious and pervasive misunderstanding
- 1: Serious distortion of the issues
- 2: Some troubling distortion of the issues
- 3: Generally accurate with no more than a few minor exceptions
- 4: Accurate, with minor omission of relevant detail
- 5: Factually accurate and complete

Content—Development, Depth and Complexity

_____ x 5 =

- 0: Lacks serious content: Surface or summary coverage only, or duplicates coursework
- 1: Unclear logic, or frequently inadequate development or depth
- 2: Develops one aspect of an issue, but uneven level or avoids alternatives
- 3: Fully develops one aspect of an important issue and acknowledges complexity
- 4: Development respects complexity of issue with a few lapses of depth or level
- 5: Develops the issue with full respect to audience and complexity

Focus and Structure

_____ x 5 =

- 0: Lacks recognizable structure
- 1: Frequent repetition, missing or irrelevant content, or serious structural problems
- 2: Weak structure or frequent lack of clear focus
- 3: Clear organization, with occasional repetitions, omissions, and/or extraneous material
- 4: Good focus and structure, with no more than occasional lapses
- 5: Exceptional structure

Use of Language

_____ x 4 =

- 0: Lacks control over language
- 1: Frequent lapses from appropriate language usage
- 2: Exhibits an accumulation of errors
- 3: Uses language appropriately
- 4: Fluent language and sentence structure, with occasional lapses
- 5: Uses sophisticated language throughout
