## Overall Presentation

### Accuracy

- 0: Serious and pervasive misunderstanding
- 1: Some troubling distortion of the issues
- 2: Accurate, with minor omission of relevant detail
- 3: Factually accurate and complete

### Development, Depth and Complexity

- 0: Unclear logic, or frequently inadequate development or depth
- 1: Develops one aspect of problem, but uneven level or avoids alternatives
- 2: Fully develops one aspect of an important issue and acknowledges complexity
- 3: Develops the issue with full respect to audience and complexity

### Focus and Structure

- 0: Lacks recognizable structure
- 1: Frequent repetition, missing or irrelevant content, or serious structural problems
- 2: Clear organization, with occasional repetitions, omissions, and/or extraneous material
- 3: Good focus and structure, with no more than occasional lapses

- 5: Physical Presentation (speaks clearly, eye contact, etc.)
